## CALLING BOARD OF DIRECTOR NOMINEES!

Our goal at Energy Capital Credit Union is to serve, grow and give back to our members. This is an opportunity for you to continue the philosophy of "people helping people" and serve the member-focused mission of our credit union.

Any qualified member wishing to be considered for a position on the Board of Directors of Energy Capital Credit Union must submit to the Nominating Committee an application to be a candidate, in the form described by the State of Texas Credit Union Department application. This application will include a written authorization for the credit union to conduct a background and credit investigation, as the credit union determines appropriate. This application must be submitted to Energy Capital Credit Union at least 80 days prior to the date of the annual meeting. The deadline for this year's nominations is Friday, December 4, 2020.

Soon after the deadline, the Nominating Committee will promptly advise each nominee of the selections it has made for candidates by written notice. Any nominee not chosen by the Nominating Committee will not be considered as a candidate for election to the Board unless within 15 days the Nominating Committee receives a written notice that the nominee wishes to still be considered as a candidate. This notice must be accompanied by a petition (in the form described by the credit union) containing the signatures of at least 10 current credit union members indicating their support for the nominee. A list of all candidates for the Board of Directors will appear in an issue of the Energy Capital Credit Union newsletter.

## INTERNATIONAL CREDIT UNION DAY

International Credit Union Day was celebrated on Thursday, October 15th. It's a day of recognizing what makes credit unions unique, and how, collectively, we help people all over the world.

Credit unions began with a very simple idea - that people could pool their money and lend money to each other. This idea of a "people's bank" started in the mid-19th century and has since spread across the world. It now includes 274 million members in 118 countries. In 1948, the Credit Union National Association declared the 3rd Thursday in October as International Credit Union Day to bring together members and celebrate.

In 1934, a small group of Humble Oil Employees came together to form what would later become Energy Capital Credit Union. At the time, loan sharks were the main source of financing, and our founders decided to lend to each other to help free one another from the harsh lending practices. Today, we are more than 17,000 members strong, and growing every day!
